

EAHS 2022-2023 Student Dress Code

STUDENT DRESS CODE (DeKalb County School District)

The atmosphere of a school must be conducive to learning. Students' appearance can positively or negatively impact the climate of a school. Students must adhere to DeKalb School District dress code requirements. Students who fail to comply with the DeKalb School District dress code requirements, as enumerated below, may be charged with Offense #25 -Student Dress Code Violation.

- Students are expected to follow all school rules governing safety in specialized programs that may require the wearing of protective clothing, safety glasses, or other similar requirements.
- Clothing or jewelry that disrupts the educational process or endangers the health or safety of other students, staff or visitors is prohibited.
- The wearing of clothing, insignia, symbols, or adornments worn or carried on or about a student which promote gangs, the use of controlled substances, drugs, alcohol, or tobacco is prohibited.
- The wearing of clothing which shows offensive and/or vulgar words, pictures, diagrams, drawings, or includes words or phrases of a violent nature, a disruptive nature, a sexual nature, or words or phrases that are derogatory regarding a person's ethnic background, color, race, national origin, religious belief, sexual orientation, or disability is prohibited.

The wearing of pants below the waist line, bare midriffs, halter tops/tank tops, tops/blouses revealing cleavage, short shorts, net/see through garments, flipflops, shoes without straps, bedroom shoes, or other footwear that interferes with freedom of movement and dresses, pants, or skirts with high splits is prohibited.

Note: Students/Parents are urged to review local school handbooks for any additional requirements related to student dress.

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ACCEPTABLE ATTIRE:

1. Pants worn at the waist.
2. Shirts that cover your midriff when in a relaxed and/or seated position.
3. Shorts and skirts that reach the fingertips in length when in a relaxed and/or seated position (including skirts with slits).
4. Shirts must have sleeves
5. Sneakers
6. Crocs
7. Sandals/Shoes with Straps

UNACCEPTABLE ATTIRE:

1. Low rider or hip hugger jeans which reveal midriffs, **leggings or jeggings**;
2. Any shirt or top which reveals midriffs (front or back);
3. Shirts or tops with low necklines; cleavage showing;
4. Muscle shirts, tank tops, sleeveless jerseys, spaghetti straps (less than 2 inches), ribbed T-shirts (wife beaters);
5. Flip flops, house shoes or any other unsafe or inappropriate footwear;
6. Sunglasses, bandanas, hats, hoods, scarves, headdress or any other such items;
7. Clothing that displays any illegal substances profanity, sexually suggestive, racially demeaning messages, or gang related messages;
8. T-shirts or tops with double meaning, crude phrases, alcoholic messages or promoting substance abuse;
9. Jewelry which promotes or display illegal substances;
10. Running shorts/short shorts/or boxer shorts;
- II. Undergarments worn as outer garments;
12. Torn clothes or holes in pants; **DISTRESSED JEANS THAT EXPOSE SKIN**
13. **Pajamas; Pajamas Top, Pajamas Socks, etc.**

14. Chains, pointed rings, dog collars, bullet belts, etc.

15. Tube tops.

Students failing to abide by the dress code will be required to change into appropriate attire or sent home. Work missed from class will be the student's responsibility. Clothing or accessories which are disruptive or detrimental to the education at EAHS will not be allowed. Certain items will be confiscated.
